
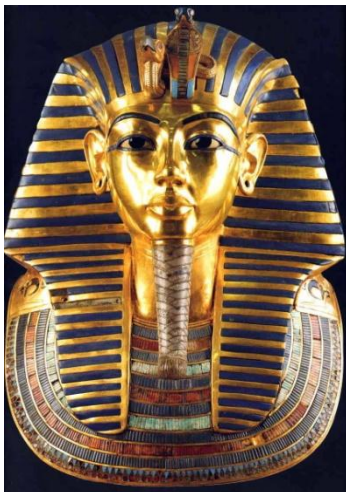


Class 2 from January 2010.




We will create pictures and use them in our writing.



Many children benefit from visiting exhibitions. The largest collection of Egyptian artefacts is in London's British Museum. If you are visiting London you may consider some time in this wonderful place. An easily overlooked item is the Rosetta stone which allowed us to crack the code of hieroglyphs.

In literacy we will study poems - in particular performing poetry. We will study information texts and where possible link to our topic on the Egyptians.




In maths we will study the units A2, B2 and C2 as indicated on the National Curriculum Numeracy New Framework.

In RE we will look at rules and choices. This mainly involves the Christian religion, but links to Judaism.
